(12.00 noon on Monday - BKK time) up to 128 players

All entrants must be the citizen of Asian and Oceania countries only and will be drawn randomly to play in 2 individual knock-out tournaments which will be run consecutively.

**Entry Fee:** The entry fee for Asia Oceania Q School this year is £560 (or 25,000 Thai baht) inclusive of vat, bank charges and fluctuation of the exchange rate.

All entries are non-refundable after the closing date. Players are eligible to enter directly on an individual basis, providing that they are in good standing with their national federation at the time of entering and competing in the Q School.

All entrants must pay their entry fee into the bank account below and upload deposit slip (in English language) on the online entry form when applying, or by credit card charge on the entry form.

**Credit card charge:** Credit card charge can also be made on the entry form on the online system after you have registered your entry.

For credit card payment, you need to fill out the entry form and submit it first. Then, log back in using your email address you entered on the entry form (case sensitive) as username and your passport number or Thai citizenship i.d. number as password to get access to credit card payment. Once you hit enter for payment, please wait until the payment is confirmed.

**Max No of players:** 128 Players

**Prize:** Qualification for 2025/2026 & 2026/2027 World Snooker Tour. Any World Snooker Tour places awarded to players are subject to WST and WPBSA approval. In the event of a player qualifying for the World Snooker Tour more than once through a recognised qualifying route, the selection will be based on chronological order with the first event in the calendar counting as the qualifying place on the World Snooker Tour. The resulting available place will revert to a concession.

<b>Players Qualifying:</b>	1 <sup>st</sup> , 2 <sup>nd</sup> Events – two finalists from each event, making a total of 4 qualifying places. After the 1 <sup>st</sup> event, the names of the successful players will be withdrawn from the 2 <sup>nd</sup> events and those players who they were drawn against shall receive a bye into the next round of that tournament. Players who qualify for the World Snooker Tour will be required to attend a MANDATORY WPBSA induction day at the start of the season. Failure to attend may result in the player being refused entry to compete in World Snooker Tour events.		
<b>Number of Frames:</b>	7		
<b>Seeding:</b>	There will be no seeding, Asian and Oceanian players falling off the World Snooker Tour from the 2023/24 season will be placed at random in the draw but seeded apart from one another in the opening rounds of the events so that they do not meet before the second round.		
<b>Round Structure / Draw / Format:</b>	Dependent on the number of entries. The draw for each tournament will be made as soon as possible after the closing date.		
<b>Q School T-shirt:</b>	There are no Q School T-shirt for sale this year.		
<b>Age Restrictions:</b>	There are no age or gender restrictions for entry to Asia & Oceania Q School, however, the WPBSA and WST reserve the right to refuse entry to any player under the age of 16 years of age as of 13 May 2025. Any player under 18 years of age as of 13 May 2025, must have their entry confirmed in writing and be accompanied to the event by a parent or guardian before competing.		
<b>Dress Code:</b>	Dress code will be dark trousers, shoes, collared plain shirt and waistcoat, <b>bow ties are required due to there will be live broadcasting on television.</b> No jeans or trainers are allowed.		
<b>Player logos to sell:</b>	3	<b>World Snooker Logos:</b>	1
<b>Brand Exclusion:</b>	Only two logos are allowed on the waistcoat, all other logos are to be worn on shirt sleeves. Details of any potential brand exclusion will be circulated in advance of the event.
